



A fully-functional Dynamo Pool table's coin mechanism contains all of these parts. The [Tripper Rod](#) raises the [Ball Flap](#) and vends the balls.

Parts are no longer available for [Older Dynamo tables with Metal Coin Doors](#). You would need to install all the parts from this photo and adapt them to fit your table (the plastic door frame wider, but not as tall). No instructions exist to make the conversion and while some have managed to make it work, we do not recommend attempting it.
