

DYNAMO CUE BALL SEPARATION



WEIGHTED:

Note 90-degree bend in ball path



MAGNETIC:

Note two 45-degree bends in ball path

No moving parts

Prior to 1993—all Dynamo tables used WEIGHTED cue ball separation with a separator that looks like the photo on the left. We stopped stocking weighted cue balls over 10 years ago, but full-line parts suppliers have them.

From 1995 to present—all Dynamo tables use MAGNETIC cue ball separation that looks like the photo on the right.

From 1993—1995, it depends on what the dealer ordering the table specified.

This illustration is also included in FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT DYNAMO POOL, which you should read when you have the chance. This means DO NOT simply order our current-model Magnetic Cue Ball because you need a cue ball. It works on all Valley and Dynamo tables built for the past 25 years, but NOT all older Dynamo pool tables. **BE SURE— OPEN THE BALL VIEW DOOR AND LOOK INSIDE FIRST**
