

A word on Dynamo Coin Foosball Parts

Dynamo Coin Foosball tables were phased out of production about 15 years ago, shortly after Valley and Dynamo merged late in the 1990s. Dynamo Home Foosball tables were still manufactured and sold for some years after, but have also since been discontinued. The current Dynamo Home Foosball tables actually have more in common with Tornado tables than 1980s-era Dynamo tables.

Parts used on the Dynamo Foosball tables common to Tornado products and other Dynamo products are still available; however, we are no longer stocking or producing any parts specific to any Dynamo Coin Foosball table.

This includes bearings, bearing washers, foam bumpers, rods (Dynamo coin rods were longer than Tornado rods), “Square chest” blue and red men, playfield artwork or glass, and any parts relating to the ball return function.

Your local distributor, online retailers and other sources may have parts available. Please, if you contact your Distributor, let them know we assured you these parts are no longer available from us. Many will say “sure, we have that” and then call us—not knowing you already checked--only to find out they can’t.

An old Dynamo Coin Foosball table that “just needs a few parts” may not be the bargain it seems.
