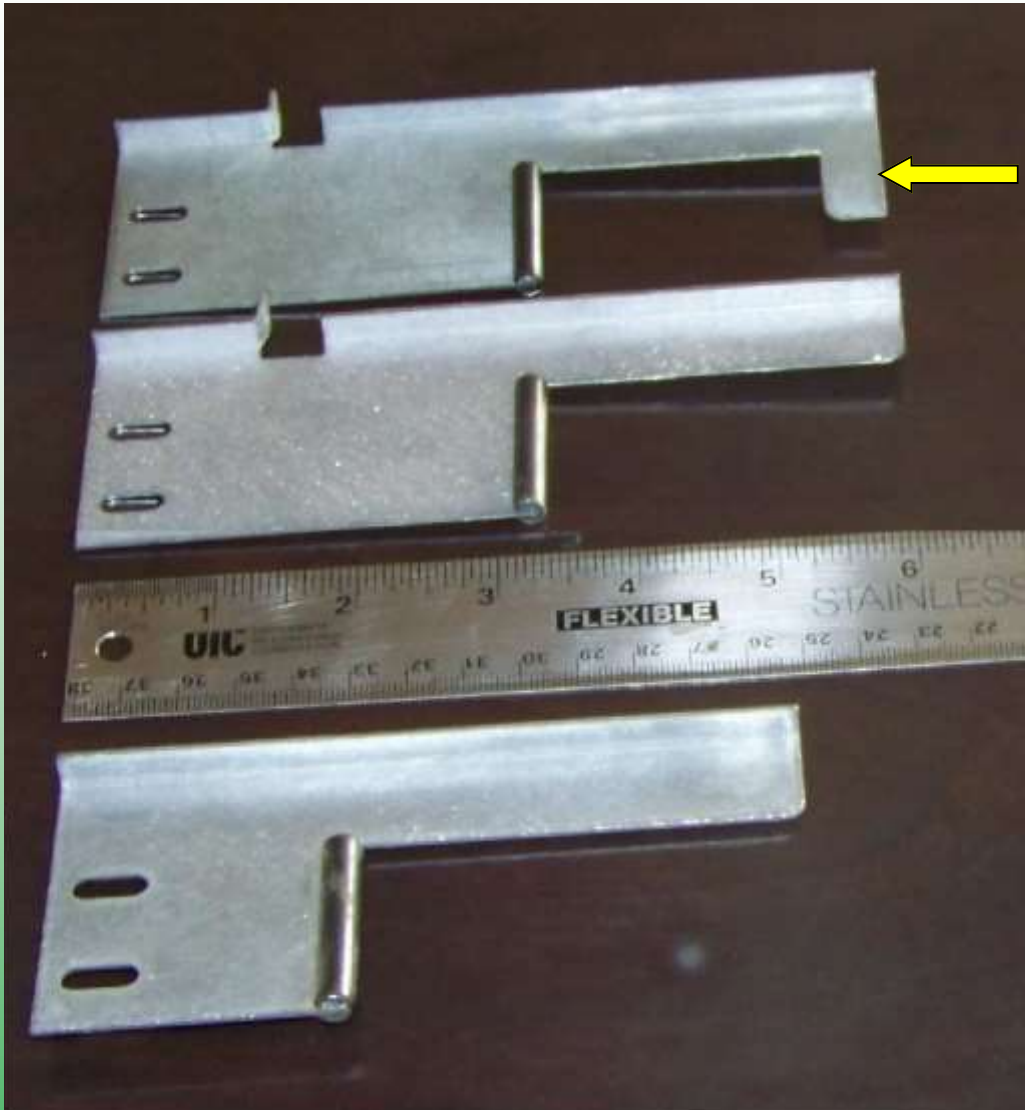


VALLEY Talks about Push Chute Extensions



20600044—EXTINCT— NO LONGER AVAILABLE

Tables from 1986's model ZD-4 used this extension, but when we introduced the DBA Great 8 we found the little L shape went right where the motor cable wanted to go. All this L does is pull the Ball Trap back down if your [S3 Hinge Bar spring](#) breaks. It is a lot less confusing to stock only one Push Chute end and replace the spring if it breaks.

20600046—CURRENT USAGE

All Valley and Dynamo tables for nearly 20 years have used this extension, even the current Panthers, Top Cats and Dynamo Sedonas on our production line. Note that the hardened piece that contacts the hinge bar is in the exact same place as on the 20600044 extension shown above. [Click this box to order it.](#)

20600045—EXTINCT AS OF OCTOBER 2012

Tables prior to 1979's model 39 used this extension—note the shorter distance between the base and the hardened steel roll pin. We still had a few, but sold out in 2012 and no more will be made.

Any table using this is now at least 40 years old.
