A fully-functional Dynamo Pool table's coin mechanism contains all of these parts. The **Tripper Rod** raises the **Ball Flap** and vends the balls.

Parts are no longer available for **Older Dynamo tables with Metal Coin Doors**. You would need to install all the parts from this photo and adapt them to fit your table (the plastic door frame wider, but not as tall). **No instructions exist to make the conversion and while some have managed to make it work, we do not recommend attempting it.**
